Narrator: Mohit and Rajiv left the ground and moved to their house.

Narrator: As they grew older, Rajiv fell into bad company. He developed friendship with Vijay and Virat.

Vijay: There is a new movie in the theatre. Let's go and see the movie.

Play - 2 - "A Thankful Day for Helpers"

Narrator 1 - The next skit we are doing is called "A thankful day for helpers"

Title: "A Thankful Day for Helpers"

Characters: 5+ 5 (Roll No 11-21)

- Narrator 1- Roll#11
- Mia: A curious and enthusiastic young girl Roll #12
- **Teacher:** A friendly and patient teacher Roll # 13
- **Doctor (optional):** A character wearing a doctor's coat and stethoscope Roll # 14
- Police Officer (optional): A character with a hat and badge Roll #15
- **Firefighter (optional):** A character in a firefighter's helmet Roll # 16
- Teacher Roll # 17
- Students- Roll # 18 Roll #21.

Setting: A classroom with a small stage area

Scene 1: Classroom Discussion

• **Teacher:** "Class, today we're going to talk about the people who help us in our community, called 'community helpers'!"

- Mia: "Like who, teacher?"
- **Teacher:** "Well, like doctors who make us feel better when we're sick, police officers who keep us safe, and firefighters who help in emergencies!"

Scene 2: Role Play

- Mia: "Can we pretend to be community helpers?"
- **Teacher:** "Of course! Let's start with Mia as a doctor!"
- Mia (as doctor): "Hello, I'm Dr. Mia. How are you feeling today?"
- **Student (as patient):** "I have a tummy ache."
- Mia (as doctor): "Don't worry, I'll give you some medicine to make you feel better!"
- **Teacher:** "Now, let's have [another student] be a police officer!"
- **Student (as police officer):** "Hi, I'm Officer [name]. Do you need any help?"
- **Student (as citizen):** "I lost my puppy!"
- **Student (as police officer):** "Let's look for your puppy together!"

Scene 3: Thank You Letter Writing

- **Teacher:** "Let's write thank you letters to our community helpers!"
- Mia: "Dear Doctor, thank you for helping me when I was sick."
- Student: "Dear Police Officer, thank you for keeping us safe."

Scene 4: A Special Thank You Assembly

- **Teacher:** "Let's imagine we're having a special assembly to thank our community helpers!"
- Mia: "Thank you to all our helpers for everything you do!"
- **Class (in unison):** "We appreciate you!"
