Degrees of Comparison:

1. **Positive Degree:** Used to describe a person or thing without comparing it to others.

Example: She is a good singer.

2. **Comparative Degree:** Used to compare two people or things.

Example: She sings better than her sister.

3. **Superlative Degree:** Used to compare three or more people or things.

Example: She is the best singer in the school.

Examples-

1. Positive: She is a good singer.

Comparative: She sings better than her sister.

Superlative: She is the best singer in the school.

2. Positive: He is a fast runner.

Comparative: He runs faster than his friend.

Superlative: He is the fastest runner in the team.
