Q.1 What is the G20 Summit 2023?

A. The G20 Summit is an intergovernmental organization comprised of 19 nations and the European Union, focused on addressing global economic concerns.

A. The G20 Summit 2023 will be held at 'Bharat Mandappam' within the ITPO Convention Centre in New Delhi's Pragati Maidan.

Q.4 How often is the G20 Summit held?

A. The G20 Summit is held annually.

Q.5 What is the theme of the G20 Summit 2023?

A. The theme of the G20 Summit 2023 is "Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam," which means "One Earth, One Family, One Future."

Q.6 What is the significance of the G20 Summit?

A. The G20 Summit brings together the world's largest economies to address critical global economic and environmental issues, representing a significant portion of the global GDP and population.

Q.7 How is the G20 Summit organized?

A. The G20 Summit operates through two tracks: the Finance Track, led by Finance Ministers and Central Bank Governors, and the Sherpa Track, led by Sherpas who represent the heads of state.

A. Brazil holds the G20 Presidency in 2024.

Q.9 What percentage of the global GDP do G20 countries represent?

A. G20 countries collectively represent around 85% of the global GDP.
