6. Word Problems.

- a) Manas spent ₹44.55 on a book and ₹15.45 on a pen. How much money did Manas spend altogether?

$$\begin{aligned} \text{Cost of a book} &= 44.55 \\ \text{Cost of a pen} &= 15.45 \\ \text{Total} &= 44.55 + 15.45 = ₹60.00 \end{aligned}$$

- b) Salman bought a sandwich for ₹77.25. He also bought a paneer roll for ₹22.25 more than the sandwich. How much did the paneer roll cost?

$$\begin{aligned} \text{Sandwich} &= 77.25 + 22.25 = 99.50 \\ \text{Paneer roll cost} &= ₹99.50 \end{aligned}$$

7. Solve the following.

- a) This is 1 dozen eggs. How many is half a dozen?



6 is half a dozen.

- b) We have 2 dozen eggs. How many eggs make up half of 2 dozens?



12 is half of 2 dozen.

- c) Share a dozen apples amongst four people. How many apples does each receive?



3 is a quarter of a dozen.
