The most famous pillar is at Sarnath (Varanasi) The top of this pillar consists of four lions sitting back to back and facing four directions.

2. Describe the stupas?

Ans. Stupas are dome shaped structures consisting of relics of Buddha. Ashoka had built 84,000 stupas all over India and Afghanistan. The surface of stupas has been mainly built with bricks and a thick layer of plaster. The famous Sanchi Stupa near Bhopal is one of the best examples.

3. Write a short note on agriculture during the Mauryan rule.

Ans. Agriculture was one of the main occupations of the people during the Mauryan Empire. Trade commerce and agriculture flourished under the guidance of farmers. They lived in the ruler areas and cultivated different crops. The irrigation facilities provided by the state to the farmers, they also help them in clearing lands.

Ans. The Mauryan Empire stretched from north along the boundaries of the Himalayas to the east in Assam. In the west it covered areas of modern Pakistan, Afghanistan and Baluchistan.

- iii) Finally internal conflicts among the ministers resulted decline the Empire.

Ans. Akbar and Jahangir both were interested in foreign trade. Akbar established a good network of roads. There foreign traders were welcome by the mughals and were given high security. They were charged low taxes as well.
