The Sun provides the light and warmth that make life on Earth possible. It is a star, but it is closer to Earth than any other star, making it appear brighter and larger in the sky. The Sun's energy reaches Earth as sunlight, which is essential for plants to grow and for the weather to function. The **Earth** is the third planet from the Sun and the only known planet to support life. It has a solid surface made up of land and oceans, and an atmosphere that contains oxygen and other gases needed by living things. Earth's atmosphere also protects us from harmful radiation from the Sun. Earth rotates on its axis, causing day and night. It also orbits around the Sun, taking 365 days to complete one revolution, which gives us one year. The **Moon** is Earth's only natural satellite. It orbits Earth and has a huge influence on our planet. The Moon causes tides in the oceans due to its gravitational pull on Earth. The Moon has no atmosphere, and its surface is covered with dust and rocky material called regolith. Unlike Earth, the Moon does not have liquid water or life. The Moon takes about 27.3 days to orbit Earth and always shows the same side to us due to its synchronous rotation.
