

- Work out the following number stories.
- Question 107 Robin has 726 Lego blocks. Emily has 107 fewer blocks than Robin. Work out the number of blocks Emily has.

Robin has 726 blocks.

Emily has 107 fewer blocks than Robin.

Emily has 726 –107 = 619 blocks.

There are 431 cars and 179 motorbikes parked in a parking lot. Work out the total number of vehicles.

431 + 179 = 610

- From a box of 2000 packets, 432 are packets of pencils, 1180 are packets of crayons, and the remaining are packets of water colours.
- Find the number of packets of water colours.
- Also, estimate your answer using rounding.

a. Number of water colour packets =
$$2000 - (432 + 1180)$$

= $2000 - 1612$

= 388 water colours.
