- State Government- Each state has a state government and it deals with matters that concern health, education and transport in the state
- Local government- looking about governance in a village or a town.

2. Write a short note on the working of the Gram Panchayat.

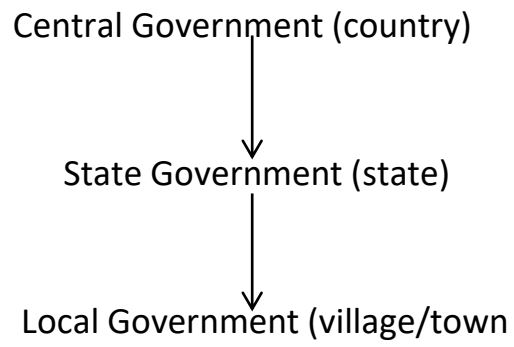
Ans. The Panchayat functions at three levels: village level (Gram Panchayat), block samiti (Panchayat Samiti) and district level (Zila Parishad). This is called the Panchayati Raj System.

- Regular meetings are held by the Gram Panchayat in the village to address various issues related to their village.
- The Gram Panchayat also appoints a Gram Sevika or Sevak. These people help the villagers by guiding them to improve their living conditions.

3. List some important functions performed by the Municipal Committees.

1. **Ans.** The Municipal Committees are responsible for the following arrangements in the cities.
- Providing clean drinking water and electricity.
 - Maintaining the hygiene and keeping the city clean.
 - Maintaining law and order, traffic control, security services.
 - Maintaining the drainage system and collecting garbage.
 - Registration of births and deaths.
