Conjunction

Joining Words: And, But, Or

Joining words, also known as conjunctions, are used to connect words, phrases, or sentences. The three main joining words are and, but, and or.

- And: used to join two similar ideas

Example: I like reading books and watching movies.

- But: used to join two opposite ideas

Example: She wanted to go to the beach, but it was raining.

- Or: used to make a choice between two things

Example: Do you want to eat pizza or burgers?
