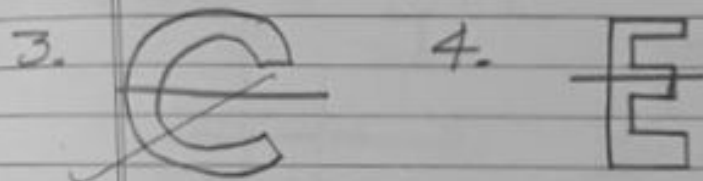
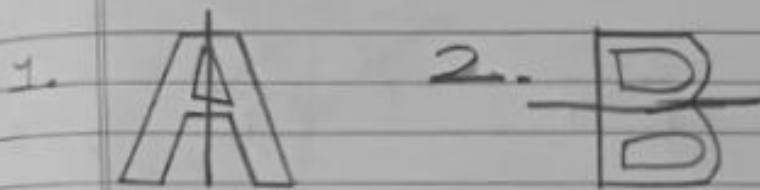

Q1. Points to remember

1. All regular shapes have line of symmetry.
2. When an object can be divided into two or more identical parts is called symmetry.
3. The line along which we fold the shape is called the line of symmetry.
4. The location or position of an object on the map is called as coordinates.
5. We can use these co-ordinates

along with compass to identify the path leading to different places.
